DROP IN REQUESTS

We have had an increase of interest in "drop ins" this school year. During COVID years we were able to accommodate most "drop ins" due to decreased class sizes; however, this year with fuller classes we may not have availability in all classes.

The "drop in" fee is \$35.00 per a day. Any request for a drop in must be made using a written form which will be sent home to you upon your request. This allows teachers ample time to prepare for additional students in their classrooms. Upon receipt of your request, we will let you know if we can accommodate your child for a drop in and if so, what the total cost will be.

We will NOT allow the switching of days. You are enrolled in specific class days and any day(s) you choose to come outside of that will result in a fee. You can not choose to trade a day you are enrolled in for another.


Our theme for the evening is SUPERHEROS! Students and dads are encouraged to wear their favorite superhero attire.

SCREENINGS WILL BE COMPLETED AT WEE WUNS ON 10/4 AND 10/5. IF YOU PLAN TO HAVE THE SCREENING COMPLETED ELSEWHERE, WE WILL NEED DOCUMENTATION FOR OUR FILES.



Houston Cy-Fair Lions Club Early Vision Screening



FREE VISION SCREENING Tues. and Wed. Oct. 4 and 5, 2022

9:30 AM

For children 6 months of age and older If you do NOT wish to have this free vision screening, you MUST sign the waiver at the front desk.



Wee Ones Preschool will be doing free KidSight Vision Screening on Tues. and Wed. Oct. 4 & 5, 2022 at 9:30 AM by the Houston Cy-Fair Lions Club, using the Plusoptix Early Vision Screener. This vision screening is done by a special image of the child's eyes to determine the presence of eye disorders. No physical contact is made with the child, and no eye drops are used during the screening. This screening is approximately 82-99% effective in detecting problems that can cause reduced vision. Participation is voluntary and there is no charge to participate. Children must be at least 6 months of age at screening. Children will be brought into the screening room in groups, and a school worker will always be present. Some vision problems, if not caught and treated early, can lead to permanent blindness. Typical vision screening where a child reads from a chart 10 feet away only checks for the ability to see far away. We use a special camera by Plusoptix, which takes a picture of the child's eyes, and within 3-5 seconds, and can detect vision problems including nearsightedness, farsightedness, astigmatism, unequal pupil size, "lazy eye" (amblyopia), and other problems. With this device, we can easily and successfully screen children from six months of age and older. Children with vision problems are not aware that they cannot see well, as they cannot compare their vision to others. Vision problems in children do not cause pain or inflammation, so parents and teachers are not aware that there is a problem. The Plusoptix Vision Screener gives us a message of PASS or REFER immediately at the screening. Children who are referred should be seen by a professional for a complete vision examination. The sooner vision problems are addressed and corrected, the better it is for the child. You will be informed of the results immediately after the test by a form sent by the school and the Lions Club. The information obtained from this vision screening is to be considered a preliminary procedure only, and does NOT constitute a diagnosis of vision problems. YOU are RESPONSIBLE for arranging for a full eye exam with an eye care professional if your child is referred as a result of the vision screening test. The Lions Club will not be held accountable for any errors of commission, omission or other misdiagnosis.

If you do NOT want your child to have this free Vision Screening, you must sign the waiver at the front desk. We look forward to screening your child for potential vision problems. · Numbers: 1-3 (3years old) 1-5 (4years old) 1-10 (Bridge).

· Colors: rojo, amarillo, verde, azul y morado.

· Family: el papá/ la mamá, el hermano/la hermana,

el abuelo/la abuela y el bebé.

· Pets : el perro, el gato, el hámster, el conejo, y el pez.

<u>Songs/finger plays/chants (continuous)</u>

· "Buenos días, ¿cómo estás?"
